Access Points for Everyone

Regional Access Points (RAPs) are the primary entry points for CEA. These entry points are resource centers where households experiencing homelessness can get help finding housing and other resources. Individuals and families facing homelessness may call ahead to schedule an appointment. New appointment times are released each week.
