As the weeks progress, their comfort grows along with knowledge of the Church and its teachings. However, they struggle to solve the Mystery of the Eucharist. It takes a devoted parish staff, a lot of prayer, and some help from above, but they do resolve the mystery and joyfully make their First Holy Communion. It includes descriptions of the Church, the Rosary, parts of the Mass, and lists familiar prayers and the commandments.
