



This guide is intended to assist Virtus users who previously registered for an in-person initial training session and wish to change to the online initial training module.

Step 1: Visit <u>www.virtusonline.org</u> and login as existing user with User ID and password. If you do not know your login ID please contact your local Safe Environment coordinator. If you do not know your password, click "need login information" and you will be prompted to reset it. Once on your profile's HOME page, click the link for the registration for upcoming session.



Step 2: It will show the session you are currently registered for. Click "change".



Step 3: The next window will have an "alert" at the top of the page because it wants you to be aware that you are making a change. SCROLL DOWN on this page to find the online training options and choose one. Then click "update pre-registration".
